Fuzzy, bumpy, gritty, smooth...texture is the way something feels when it is touched, or the way it looks like it would feel if it could be touched. Create your own work of art that demonstrates the use of texture in a realistic or creative way.

*Pieces selected for display will be determined by how well they represent the theme of **TEXTURE**, the quality of work, and available gallery space. To help us create the best collection possible, we ask **teachers** submitting art on behalf of their class to **make a pre-selection of entries** so that there is a variety of inspired works.*

Kindergarten through eighth grade **students or their teachers may submit art**. Artwork must have been created August 2023–February 2024. Only one entry per person -this includes collaborations. **Each work of art should have a title**. Two-dimensional art must be **no larger than 12"x18"**. It is suggested that it be mounted on or matted with colored construction paper; it must be **unframed**. Three-dimensional art is accepted as exhibit space allows. Each artwork must be accompanied by a **completed entry form** and **delivered to the Museum** located at 302 Second Avenue East, Kalispell, MT. Entries will be accepted **February 6-24, 2024**.

Artwork may be picked up from the Museum between April 16 and May 18, 2024.
