

# **HOCKADAY**MUSEUM OF ART Mark D. Norley Memorial Scholarship for Visual Art

The Hockaday Museum of Art, Northwest Montana's premier art museum, is offering a \$1,000 visual arts scholarship to a graduating senior visual art student in memory of longtime volunteer and arts educator Mark D. Norley (1931-2020). A lifelong arts educator, Kalispell resident Mark Norley eagerly supported opportunities for young people to develop their skills and to consider careers in the arts. Mark was a valued Hockaday supporter who generously donated his time not only to the Hockaday but also to many area nonprofits. To honor Mark, The Hockaday and James Udick in 2021 established the Mark D. Norley Memorial Scholarship for Visual Art, to be awarded annually to a deserving graduating local high school senior visual art student.

#### Eligibility

Graduating high school seniors attending public, private or home schools from Flathead, Lake, Lincoln, Sanders, and Glacier Counties are eligible to apply. The recipient may use the funds for college/university tuition or an approved art workshop, masterclass, or art residency. Any visual art medium will be considered (painting, drawing, photography, printmaking, 3-D design, ceramics, illustration, graphic design, film/video, costume/fashion).

#### **Selection Process**

The selection committee will consist of HMA Executive Director, HMA Director of Education, HMA Board of Directors representative, an area artist, and a community representative. Scholarship winner will be notified on or before May 1, **2024.** Winner will be presented with award at School Honors Awards event (if permitted) and announced on HMA website, press release, and social media.

#### **Application Deadline**

Application deadline is April 5, 2024.

#### **Submission process**

Completed attached application, a letter of recommendation, high school transcript or equivalent, and 5-7 digital images of recent work should be sent AS ONE DIGITAL .PDF COMBINED ATTACHMENT FILE (CAN HAVE MULTIPLE PAGES IN THE FILE) to <a href="https://hockadaymuseumofart@gmail.com">hockadaymuseumofart@gmail.com</a> by May 2, 2022, 10 MB total or less, please. #### Winner requirements

Recipients of the scholarship will:

- Participate in HMA press release and announcement of the award May-June 2024
- No later than 6 weeks after the presented award, notify the Hockaday Museum of Art of enrollment in selected college or art program and provide contact information for where to send the funds as USD check.
- Within 6-8 weeks of receiving the award and check, send a mailed or emailed thank you letter to the Hockaday: Hockaday Museum of Art C/O Mark Norley Scholarship 302 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave E Kalispell, MT 59901
- Within 6 months of the award, send a brief update to the Hockaday Museum of Art outlining how the scholarship has impacted their art education experience.
