Form in art refers to objects which have length, width, and height. It exists in both real and implied manners. Examples of real forms include sculpture, relief carving, pop outs on a picture, origami, ceramics, and mobiles. Implied forms can be found in drawings and paintings where the illusion of three dimensions is created with the use of light showing contrast of highlights and shadow areas or by using lines that show length, width, and height.

Pieces selected for display will be determined by how well they represent the theme of **art in three dimensions**, the quality of work, and available gallery space. To help us create the best collection possible, we ask teachers submitting art on behalf of their class to **make a pre-selection of entries** so that there is a variety of inspired works.

Kindergarten through eighth grade **students or their teachers may submit art**. Artwork must have been created August 2024–February 2025. Only one entry per person -this includes collaborations. **Submitted art should have a title**. Wall hanging art should be unframed and **no larger than 12"x18"**. We suggest it be mounted on or matted with colored construction paper. Sculptural forms with a base larger than 10"x10" must receive approval prior to submission. Each artwork must be accompanied by a **completed entry form** and **delivered to the Museum** located at 302 Second Avenue East, Kalispell, MT. Entries will be accepted **February Feb 4-18, 2025**.

Artwork may be picked up from the Museum between April 8 and May 2, 2025.
